Ram Lal Anand College was founded in the year 1964 by late Shri Ram Lal Anand, a senior advocate in the supreme court of India, in response to the growing social demand in the sixties for providing educational opportunities at the university level. The college was initially managed by the Ram Lal Anand Trust. It was later

taken over by the University of Delhi. Since 1973, it has been run by the University of Delhi as a University Maintained Institution.

The college is located in the picturesque surroundings against the backdrop of the Aravalli ranges in the neighbourhood of the south campus of the University of Delhi and several other educational institutions. It has a vast campus, spread over ten acres of land with green lawns and elegant buildings of much sprawling architectural merit. EXPERIENTIAL LEARNING

"For the things we have to learn before we can do them, we learn by doing them"-Aristotle.

Experiential learning conjointly referred to as (EXL) is that the method of learning through expertise, and is a lot of specifically outlined as "learning through reflection on doing". Experiential learning methodology could be a well-known model in education, training, facilitation, work and organizational development. It is Associate in nursing immersive, participant targeted active approach to learning that engages learners of all ages, backgrounds and knowledge levels. It is effectively utilized in faculties, education, therapy, company coaching and alternative areas for academic learning, personal development and skills building. The general construct of learning through expertise is ancient. But as an articulated educational approach, experiential learning is of much more recent vintage. Beginning in the 1970s, David A. Kolb helped develop the modern theory of experiential learning, drawing heavily on the work of John Dewey, Kurt Lewin, and Jean Piaget. Experiential learning has significant teaching advantages. Peter Senge, author of The Fifth Discipline (1990), states that teaching is of utmost importance to motivate people. Learning only has good effects when learners have the desire to absorb the knowledge. Therefore, experiential learning requires the showing of directions for learners.

Experiential learning requires self-initiative, an "intention to learn" and an "active phase of learning'. Experiential learning is said to happen or take place when participants get immersed cognitively, emotionally, behaviourally and are supported by a facilitator in reflecting, processing the experiences, emotions, thoughts, and actions to get an insight in a safe learning environment, leading to change in perspective, understanding, thought, and behaviour. As higher education continues to adapt to new expectations from students, experiential learning in business and accounting programs has become more important. With reference to this study, employers note that graduating students need to build skills in "professionalism" – which can be taught via experiential learning. Students also value this learning as much as industry.

Experiential learning is most easily compared with academic learning, the process of acquiring information through the study of a subject without the necessity for direct experience. While the dimensions of experiential learning are analysis, initiative, and immersion, the dimensions of academic learning are constructive learning and reproductive learning. Though both methods aim to install new knowledge in the learner, academic learning does so through more abstract, classroom-based techniques, whereas experiential learning actively involves the learner in a concrete experience.

SOFT SKILLS TRAINING

Soft Skills are the set of skills that a person should possess in order to face life's daily challenges successfully and to positively adapt to it. This would build the self confidence in an individual to handle life challenges in a more effective manner. In order to visualize a clearer picture on soft skills, let us now look at some more definitions,

- 1. Soft skills are the behaviours and characteristics that people demonstrate unconsciously and routinely
- 2. For success in the workplace, the contributions of soft skills are 85% and contributions of technical skills are 15%

- 4. Soft skills will take you higher in your profession while giving you the technical skills to provide an efficient service
