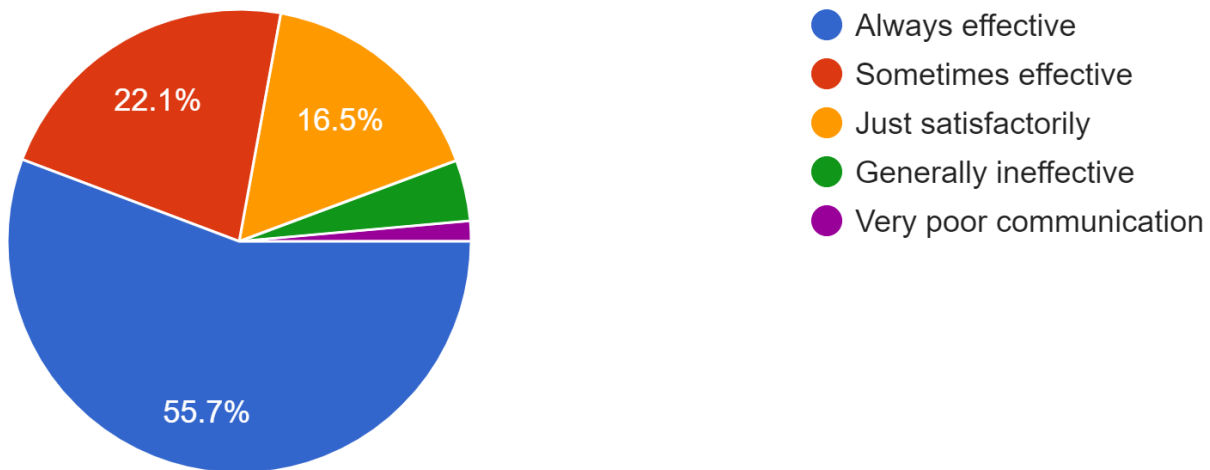

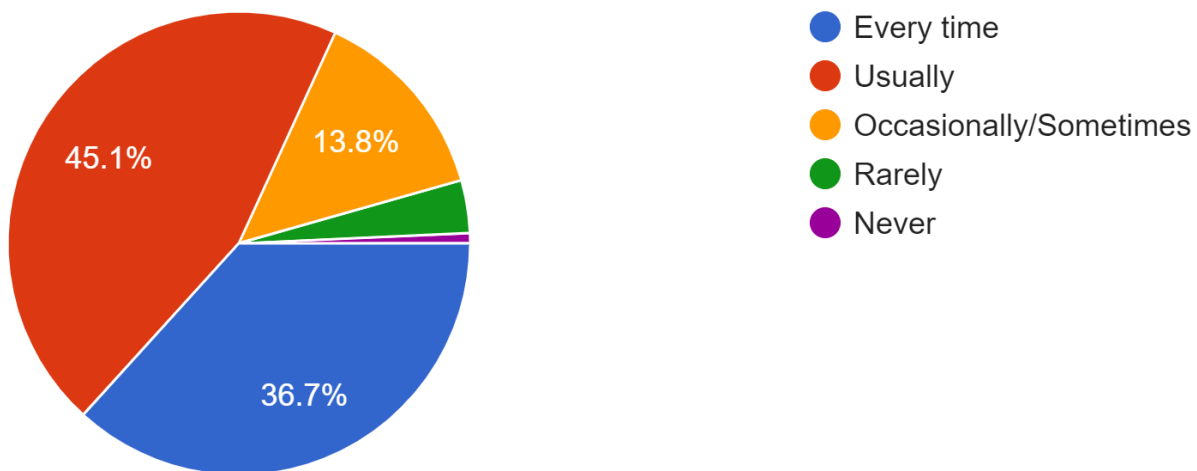

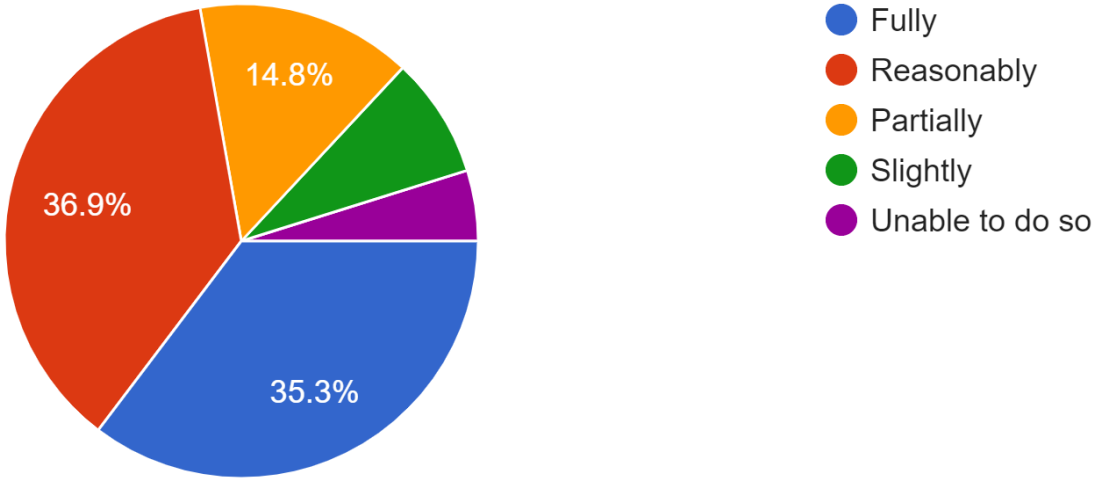
Q1: How well were the teachers able to communicate?



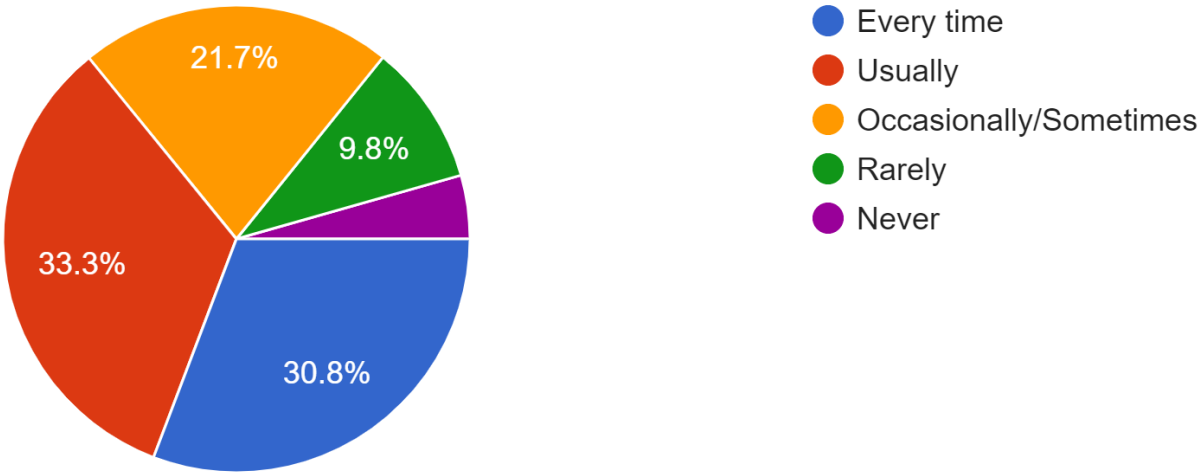
Q2: The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications.



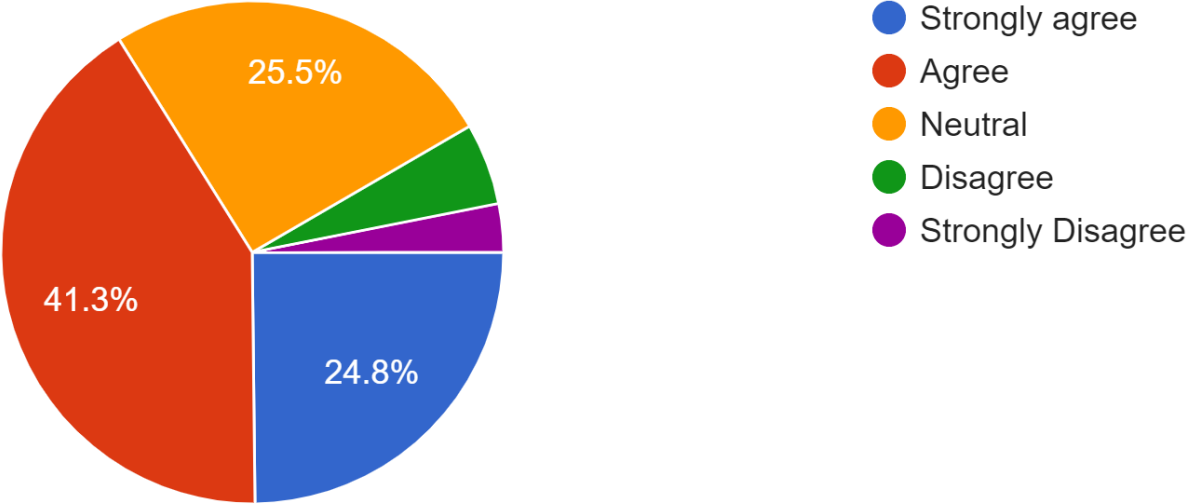
Q3: The teachers identify your strengths and encourage you with providing right level of



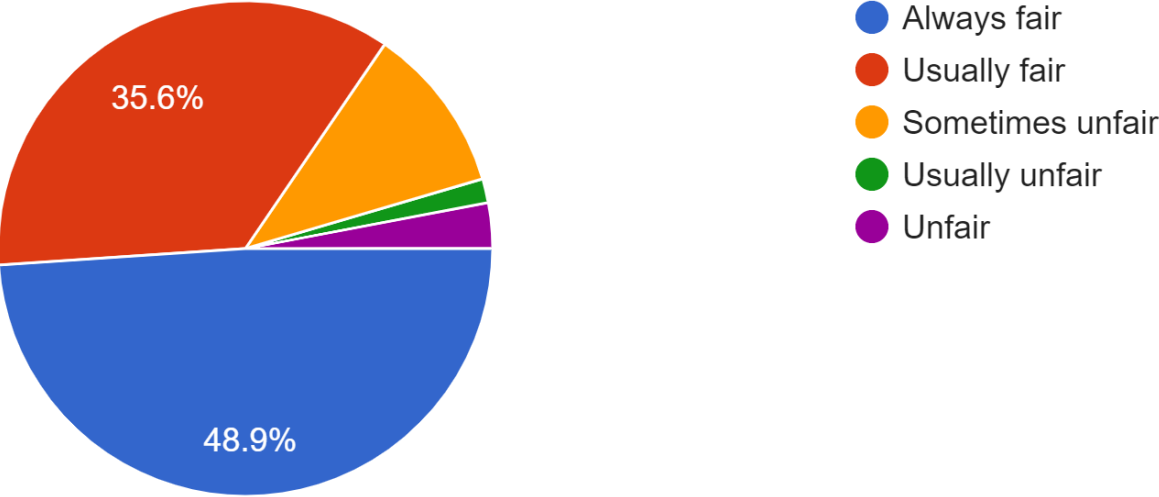
Q4: Teachers are able to identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome them.



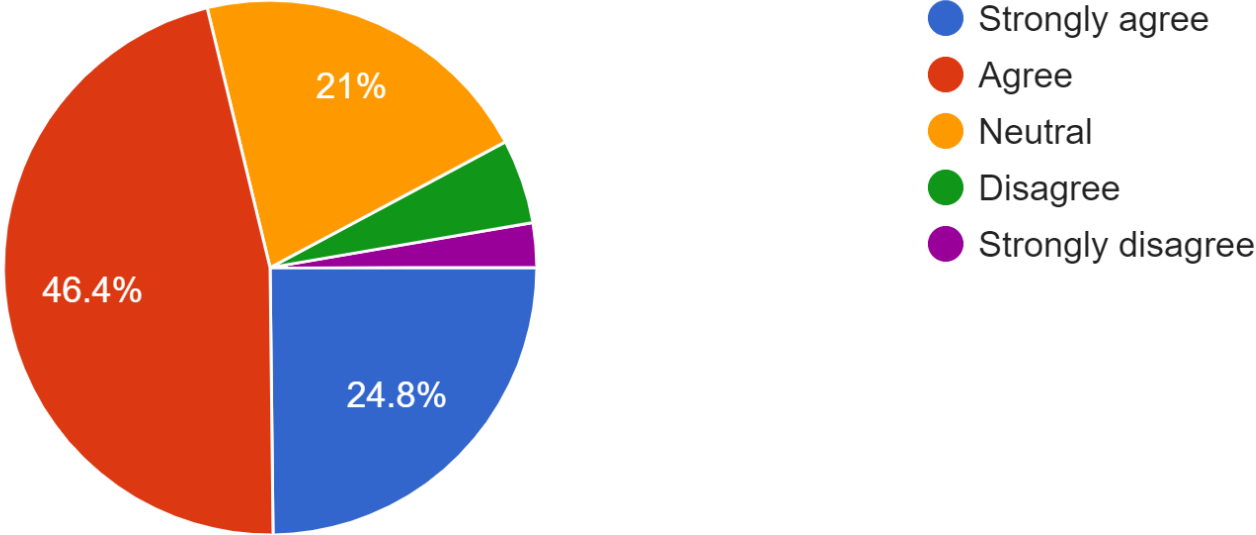
Q5: Teachers encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities.



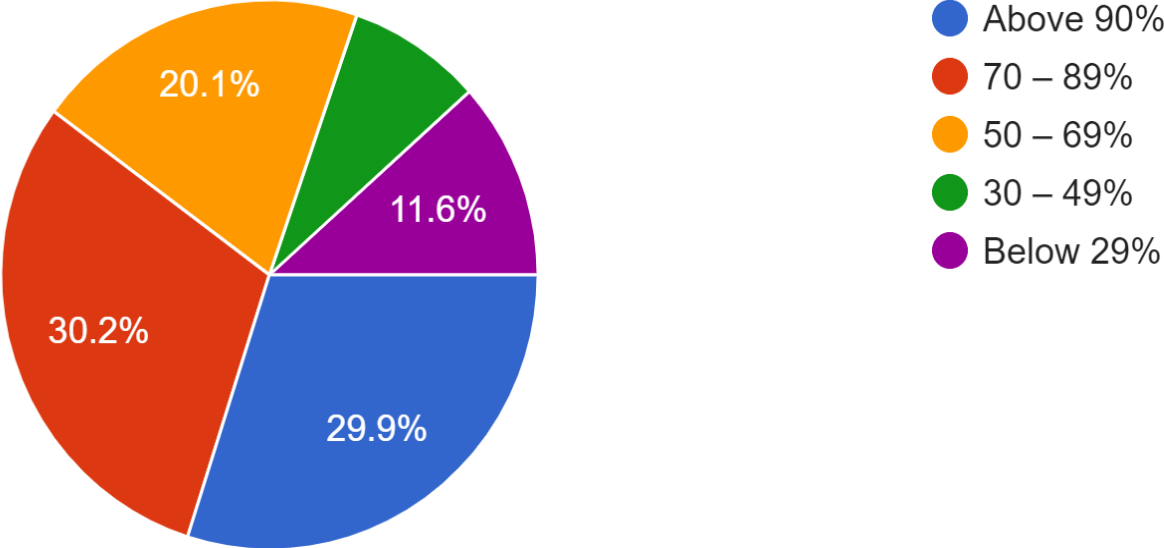
Q6: Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers.



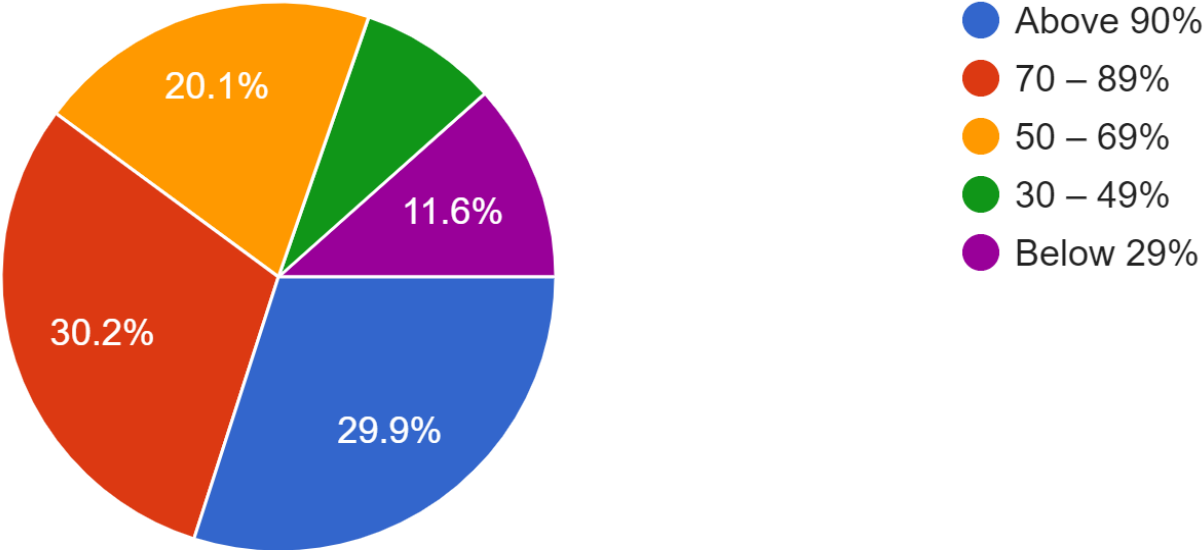
Q7: The institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow.



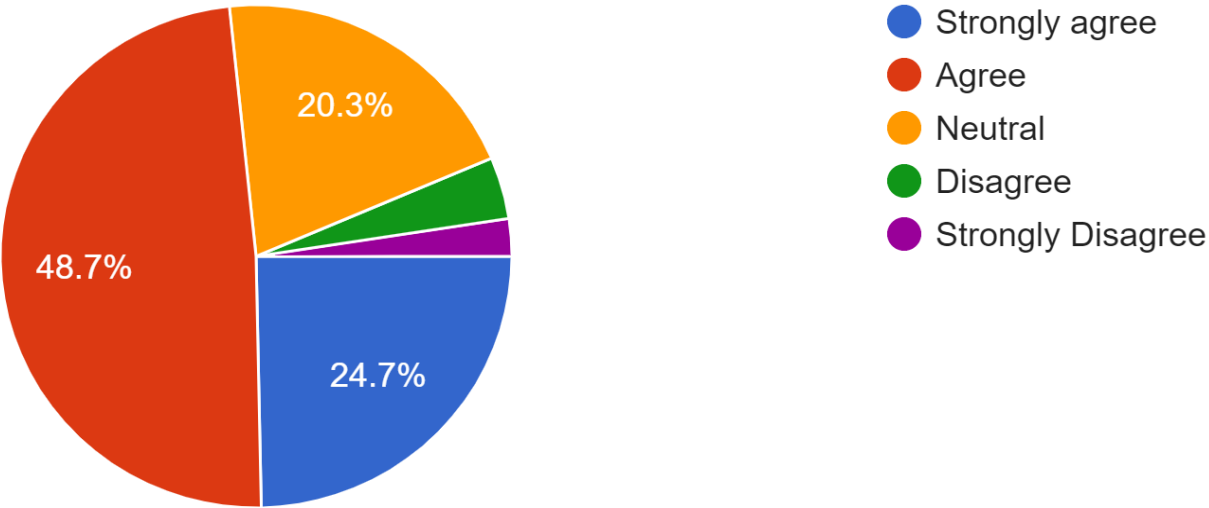
Q8: Efforts are made by the institute/ teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make you ready for the world of work.

### **Q11. Suggestions:**

The suggestions/comments received from students of 2019-20 are summarized below which will be taken for further improvements:

1. Offline classes are a preferred mode of teaching and learning.

4. Easy Availability of laptops for students for carrying out academic work
5. Use of ICT tools by all the teachers is requested.
6. All the Teachers must make a google calender for the google meet link and must record the class so that we can have access to recording of the classes and in case of network problem we can understand the concept taught in the class afterwards.
7. We need good exposure to industry by successful people from the industry. Also learn necessary new age skills from Property trained professionals.
8. Provide notes/ppts after syllabus completion
9. Active placement cell for job needs of students. Please encourage placements in our college, all other college through Delhi university are offering great internships
10. Better infrastructure and other arrangements in classrooms/campus
11. more group and analytical projects
12. Field based projects for BJMC students for more exposure
13. Regular feedback from students by teachers to check for improvement in teaching learning process
