International conference on 'Gandhi and the global peace'

After this, the circle organized a two day International conference on 18th and 19th February, 2022. The topic of the conference was "Gandhi and the global peace " with the blessings of principal Prof. Rakesh kumar Gupta and convener of Gandhi study circle Prof. Subhash Chander Dabas the conference was successfully organized and was attended by more than 170 participants. Briefing of the event is as follows:-

Inaugural session was hosted by Prof. Subhash Chander Dabas who introduced the circle to the participants and it was followed by

a warm welcome address by Principal Prof. Rakesh Kumar Gupta. An address was given by guest of honor by Dr. Dipankar Shri Gyan (director, Gandhi Smriti & Darshan Samiti, New Delhi) Followed by the keynote address by senior prof. RC. Bharadwaj (Director, Gandhi Bhawan, University of Delhi)

In session 2 we had our guest speaker Prof. Gianluigi Segalerba and Dr. Kathrin Bouvot from the University of Vienna, Italy. They spoke on "Gandhi's search for the individual's moral foundations" In the 3rd session we had Prof. Mark Juergensmeyer (University of California, Santa Barbara, USA) he shared his views on "A Gandhian approach to terrorism"

In the 4th session Prof. Douglas Allen, (Professor of philosophy University of Maine, USA) enlightened us on "how we can relate Gandhi's focus on decentralization and nonviolent peace to the issue of globalism, peace and non-violence in India and in the world.

In 5th session Prof. Anant Giri, was a speaker (Professor Madras Institute of Development Studies, India) who talked about "walking & meditating with Gandhi ji: truth, God, Justice & Ahimsa"

After this 3 more sessions were organized as a part of the International Conference in which different speakers & paper presenters participated. The valedictory speech was given by our chief guest Prof. Shri Prakash Singh (director, South campus, University of Delhi). Valedictory session of the event address by Prof. DP.
