CALL FOR PAPERS



Gandhi Study Circle, Ram Lal Anand College is organising a Two-Day International Conference on Gandhi and Global Peace. This conference will be conducted on Google Meet platform on 18-19 February, 2022. There will be four sessions of three hours each distributed among two days.

Ram Lal Anand College is an affiliate college of University of Delhi. Since 1964, Ram Lal Anand College has been imparting education at undergraduate and postgraduate level in Science, Humanities and Commerce streams. The college focuses upon the holistic development of the students by instilling human values and life ethics. Gandhi Study Circle of the college is a very active society working towards the understanding of Gandhian principles and instilling these values among students. The main aim and objective of the circle is to promote Gandhian values and nation building projects. In the last few years this society has brought laurels to the college and has not left any stone unturned in spreading the message of Gandhiji among students and faculty of the college. Taking into consideration the role of Gandhian philosophy related to Global Peace in present scenario with a boost from Government of India, Gandhi Study Circle of Ram Lal Anand College, University of Delhi is organising a Two Day International Conference on Gandhi and Global Peace (गाँधी एवं विश्वशांति) on Google Meet platform on 18-19 February, 2022. Contributors are invited to present papers related to the aforementioned theme.

- 1. Accepted papers will be published in the proceedings of the International Conference.
- 2. Academic Committee will check the quality of papers and communicate the decision to the authors.
- 3. All papers will be checked for plagiarism and more than 10% of plagiarism will be unacceptable.
- 4. Use Times New Roman, 12 point font in double space while writing the manuscript.
- 5. Word limit of the paper will be between minimum 1500 words and maximum 2000 words.
- 6. 5 to 10 minutes will be given to each participant for the presentation of the paper.
- 7. MLA format of referencing will be used for citations in the text and at the end of the paper.
- 8. Paper should be written either in English or in Hindi(only Kruti Dev font).
