COURSE DESCRIPTION

The proposed course would re-imagine public policy from the bottom-up and explore innovative approaches to public policy strategy, design and delivery in contemporary times marked by economic meltdowns, deepening digital divide and rapidly mutating invisible virus accentuating inequity and much social turmoil in many parts of the globe.

The course would offer a substantive insight about what goes into making a public policy, what shapes it and how public policy professionals with a creative mind and ears to ground reality can make a difference in diverse contexts.

The course would interrogate the political, economic and social linkages that impact contemporary public policy. It would also help examine how data and evidence in digital ecosystem are redesigning how public policy is to be scrutinized, re-made and practiced. The learners would be trained how to combine theory and practice to promote out of box approaches for policy design and delivery. Highly applied in nature, the course would draw on diverse cases of policy making nationally and at the level of the provinces. Students enrolled would interact with domain experts from agencies such as CPR(Center for Policy Research), NITI Aayog, IDSA(Institute of Defense Studies and Analysis), UGC , DDC(Dialogue and Development Commission),Delhi Bio-diversity Council,to name a few.
