
A total of 11 students turned in the assignment assigned to them on the 1<sup>st</sup> October 2021 and they were given 2 days to submit it.

Spending time with my Dadi has always been a great stress reliever for me. It's like I get to feel the past just by listening to her. On the occasion of International Day of Older Persons, I decided to have a little chat with her about how she spent her childhood, what used to be her favourite pass-times, her family, and much more.

Came to India after the partition from Pakistan, she grew up with six siblings and her parents. She told me about how all of them were really close, and how they had spent time helping their mother with the household chores. In the summers, all of them used to eat food together, while her mother made and served hot chapatis, with all of them sitting around the tandoor. In winters, everyone used to sit around the angeethi for the dinner.

Growing up, she told me about how few resources and they had, yet they all used to happily manage with what they got. It was less but it was enough to keep them happy. For instance, she tells me how she and her siblings used geometry boxes as a piggy bank for keeping their pocket money and savings. Once she had collected enough to splurge on buying four suits for her cousin's wedding. She had learnt stitching, which used to be her pass-time. She stitched those four suits herself and wore them to the wedding, to which her younger sister was complaining to her mother why she gets to wear so many new clothes. Her mother explained that she had used her own savings to buy them. Unlike now, they rarely used to get new clothes, particularly on festivals, which was the reason for their excitement. Talking about festivals, she told me about Dusshera. They used to enjoy seeing the Ramleela, which started 10 days before Dusshera near their house. They even used to see the floats in Ajmere Gate which portrayed the different characters of the Ramayana.


Talking about her education, she mentioned that every sibling had to give a treat to the whole family on getting good grades. When she received second division in Arts, she threw everyone a 'Mango party'. She used her pocket money to buy five kgs of Dusshehri mangoes. They took a bucket with cold water, soaked the mangoes for an hour, and everyone circled around the bucket and enjoyed them after dinner. Earlier, there weren't used to be any refrigerators or anything to keep the fruits and vegetables fresh. So, in the evening they used to wait for their mother to come back from the market and serve them fresh fruits. It was these simple things that had so much significance in their lives. They enjoyed these little moments to the fullest.

They used to sleep on cots in the drawing room. They took out the table and laid cots in its place. Earlier, the weather used to get chilly much earlier than it does now, particularly Mid-October. Once they were up in the morning, they used to be afraid to go back to bed, of the fear that they might be scolded for sleeping till late.

Talking to her makes me realise how much times have changed. Everything was much simpler back then. People used to find happiness in the simplest of things. Sometimes it makes me wish that I could go back in time and experience life the way older people have. Maybe that's why I enjoy listening to my Dadi talk about her stories and experiences so much. It's a way of looking back into the past, just by hearing it today. I hope you enjoyed reading this as much as I enjoyed listening to her!

On 1<sup>st</sup> October, me and my family went to meet her. She recognises my father very well and my uncle and aunt say it's because she loved him the most since he's the youngest in the family. My grandmother sits, holding my father's hand and listens to us talk, talks to us and laughs at random times. My dad and her have a chemistry where my dad can understand what she's trying to say and they both then laugh with each other and leave us clueless.

This time, we discussed about how her early years were. The best anecdote that I heard was of my grandmother bringing puppies to the house. She loves animals and when she used to come back from the farm, if she would see a puppy on the way, she would bring it home and then my dad and his brothers and sisters would have to take the puppy back. others taken 15 minutes. Scoring was based on speed with accuracy so deserving candidates were selected for prizes.


