With the ongoing effects of the COVID-19 pandemic, climate change, and economic instability disproportionately impacting persons with disabilities, having a voice in governance is crucial.

Gandhi was critical of the modern railways, and this topic too was discussed in great detail. His relationship with and influence on Nehru, yet their differences of opinion of development models was discussed next. The purpose of this webinar was to understand Gandhi's views on the environment in a holistic manner. It helped us realize how Gandhi is still an inspiration to modern day environmentalists like Vandana Shiva and Ram Guha, who have discoursed at length his dialectic opinion on various tenets of the environment.

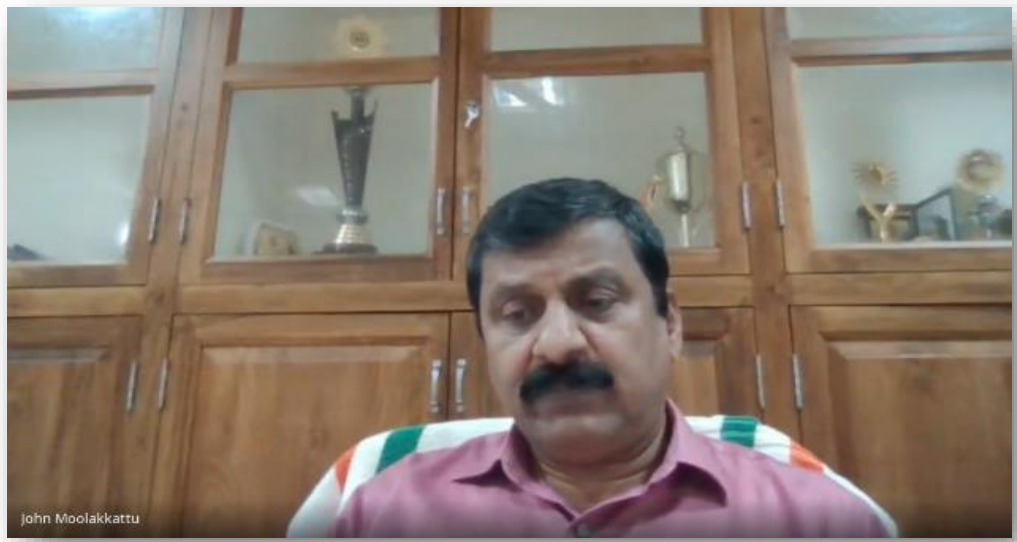
