
Orientation Programme



Brief feedback report: Leading up to International Women's Day on March 8th, the Women Welfare Advisory Committee (WWAC) of Ram Lal Anand College orchestrated a vital initiative: a self-defense workshop tailored for the female students of the institution, held on March 5th, 2024. This collaborative effort was made possible with the invaluable assistance of the Special Police Unit for Women and Children of the Delhi Police. The groundwork for this empowering event was laid through a series of informative discussions led by WWAC members, enlightening students about the significance of self-defense. The workshop itself, a blend of enlightening lectures and practical demonstrations, captured the attention of approximately 100 eager participants. Attendees were guided through an array of fundamental self-defense techniques crucial for navigating potentially perilous situations. Techniques such as the Hammer Strike, Elbow Strike, Palm Strike, and Rear Neck Chokehold were demonstrated, equipping students with essential skills to safeguard themselves effectively.

Moreover, participants received valuable insights into everyday practices that enhance personal confidence and safety within their surroundings. The session fostered an open forum for students to pose questions and seek guidance based on their own experiences, with a dedicated team from the Delhi Police on hand to provide expert responses.

Feedback from participants echoed a resounding sentiment of empowerment and enhanced self-assurance, affirming the workshop's effectiveness in bolstering the confidence of the attending students.
