It consisted the following activities:

Bid-To-Build- The bid to build was a marketing competition, held in 3 different rounds. In total 7 teams participated in the competition. The first round was the bidding round in which the teams had to buy at least 2 products each and had to make a single product/company with those products in the further rounds. After this round 2 teams were disqualified and the rest 5 teams went on to the next round which was the Presentation making round. The teams then made there presentations and presented the same to our judges, which were Mr. Akarshan Sethi and Ms Pooja. After this round the final round came up, which was the case study round. Our judges cross questioned the participants and gave them case studies for their products made.

After this round, the judges declared the winner and the runner up for the competition. In essence, the competition was a testament to the innovative power of business building and the unwavering passion of the students involved. It left an indelible mark on everyone involved, creating a legacy that will continue to inspire future generations of competitors.
