Course Description

Departing from the established assumptions that disability is a mere deficit and a constricted corporal condition, this course addresses the phenomenon as a domain of knowledge, a'lived experience' as much as a framework for interrogation.

Thus, the certificate course consists of four modules to be completed by the candidate in prescribed credit hour. The introductory module includes various approaches and concepts of disability. The Second module entitled Foundation and its relation with other similar issues connected to Disability Studies. Module Three will describe the "Disability and diverse need of persons with disabilities". Apart from other concerns, this module would help students interact and from domain experts learn across geographies. The last module would be on policy, health care, employment, and integration. These four modules will have the following course content.

About Ram Lal Anand College

Ram Lal Anand College is a University Maintained College and was founded in the year 1964 by Late Shri Ram Lal Anand, a senior advocate in the Supreme Court of India to provide educational opportunities at the university level.
