





Mr. Parth Bhalla is a serial entrepreneur with eight years of profound experience in blockchain/Web3, Al, neuroeconomics, and public speaking. Parth went from a school student to a 6-figure tech founder at the age of 24, sold a company for \$M, patented a blockchain infrastructure tech at 26, worked with governments and a financial institution on blockchain infrastructure across verticals, and is an active public speaker.

• Summary of the event:

The Dying Pitch, a business bidding and revival contest, provided participants with a challenging opportunity to showcase their financial knowledge and decision-making skills. The contest consisted of multiple rounds, starting with a preliminary quiz to shortlist participating teams. In Round 1, teams were allotted a prize pool of ₹300 Crores and had to strategically choose companies to revive. Round 2 involved creating PowerPoint presentations outlining their business plans and resource allocation. In Round 3, teams pitched their ideas to the judges, demonstrating their strategies for revival and justifying additional funding. Winners were decided based on equity exchanged, the strength of their business models, and relevance to the task. Cash prizes were awarded to the winner and runners-up, with the winner receiving ₹2,000 and the runner-up receiving ₹1,000. The contest provided a platform for participants to showcase their skills in financial management and strategic thinking.
