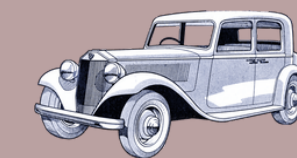

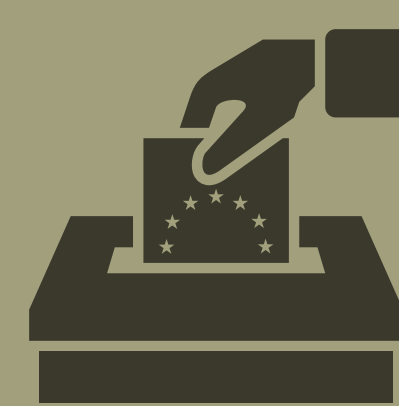
# VINTAGE CAR RALLY



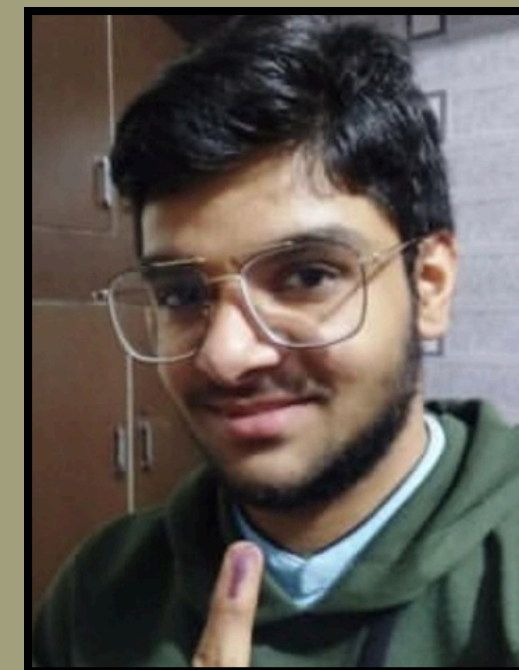

# POSTER MAKING COMPETITION



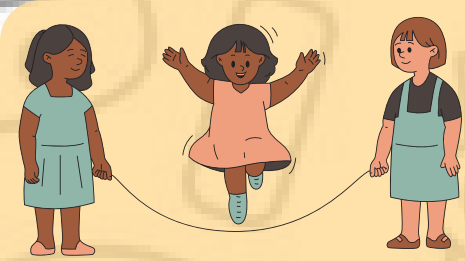

- Shruti Kumari (B.Com (H)) earning the 3rd Position.





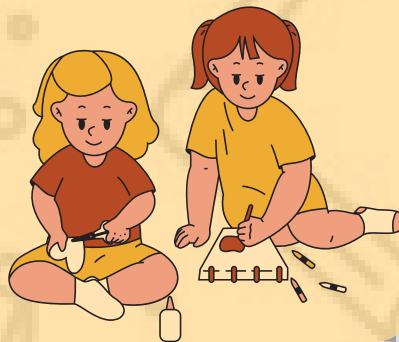


# EDUCATION CAMP

The competition witnessed enthusiastic participation from 20 teams in the first round. After a rigorous competition, only 6 teams qualified for the second round. The winners of the quiz were:

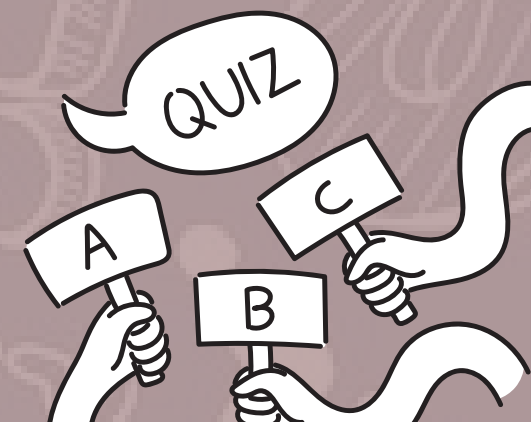
1st Position: Lakshay Sharma and Raghvi
