Guidelines for Book Bank Facility for the Needy and Meritorious students

1. The facility of book bank will be available to all needy and meritorious students at the college admitted under NEP:UGCF-2022. The books under this facility will be issued for the whole semester to 12 students of each class as per the distribution approved by the Governing body in its meeting held on 4.2.2021.

Students belonging to OBC Category	:	03
Students belonging to SC Category	:	02
Students belonging to ST Category	:	01
Students belonging to EWS Category	:	01

2. The college library will procure 12 such sets, each containing three core paper books, for both odd and even semester for each programme. These collections will be allocated to needy and meritorious students by the library.
3. The TIC's in consultation with the faculty members of respective departments have recommended three books for the 3 core papers (one book per core paper), based on EC approved NEP:UGCF-2022 syllabus of **semester I, III and V** of University of Delhi. For **semester II, IV and VI**, the recommendation may be submitted by 15th December 2025. The distribution of books for both odd and even semesters shall be completed within one month from the commencement of each semester..
4. The books recommended must cover most of the syllabus of the core paper and should be from prescribed "suggested readings" mentioned in the syllabus.

5. If a comprehensive book covering the entirety of the core paper's syllabus is unavailable, an alternative approach involving assembling relevant sections/units from various sources into a spiral-bound compilation can be done. This compilation should effectively cater to the necessities of the core course. The TIC should submit one copy of this compilation and the college library will oversee the photocopying and preparation of sets of these compilations.

6. The books recommended should preferably be authored by Indian writers or published by Indian publication houses, or be Indian editions.

7. The library committee will put up a notice inviting applications from students wishing to avail book bank facility.

8. The applications by students must be supported by income certificate of parents (To be eligible to apply the Income should be below 5lacs per annum) and mark sheet of last academic year examination passed; for example Class XII mark sheet for I year students, I year mark sheet for II year students, and so on.

9. The library staff will issue the sets to the students as per the decision of the library committee for the complete semester.
