The two eliminatory stages shall be as follows:

Pen & Paper round (1st stage):

- · Questions shall display on screen
- Total number of questions shall be 30
- · Maximum time for each question shall be 30 seconds
- Participants will receive a paper sheet for answering the displayed questions
 Only 10 qualified teams will be nominated for second stage

Picture Quiz (2nd stage):

- · 3 images will display in front of each qualified team
- Participants will need to understand the symbolic significance of each image and have to prepare answers accordingly
- · Maximum time shall be 60 seconds
- Only 5 qualified teams will be nominated for final stage.

KBQW (final stage):

- · 5 nominated teams will appear for this round
- . There shall be total 15 questions with division in three "Kotis" (stages)
- · Questions will be displayed on screen and will be recited by host/speaker simultaneously
- · Participants will be allowed to quit in the middle of the game

A holistic existence of one and all, without any sectarianism and hierarchization is the purpose of this academic pursuit. PPASC organizes lecture series, provides texts to students for ready reference apart from the college library collection, and intends to inculcate an academic ambience and the necessary confidence in Undergraduate students to metamorphose them into an informed research scholar – for the benefit of the individual, the communities concerned, and the nation at large. PPASC plans to organize a Seminar series where papers on a defined topic can be presented and then published for a larger readership and for an ensuing future.

Equal Opportunity Cell (EOC):

Once students from various backgrounds and identities enroll in the institution, EOC believes in creating a common platform where equity of treatment and equality in opportunity becomes the only practice, and an effort be made to create a microcosmic arrangement, where students find a fertile ground for utmost maximization of their talent, hard work and intellectual growth.

Concept Note:

In the discourse of the modern nation-state, the most fundamental question that surfaces is: whose nation? Does the discourse of the nation-state holistically encompass every section of the society – which remains hierarchized and sectarianized in multiplicitous ways? It's a fact that the socio-politico-cultural and economic sensibility of the idea of nation relates, corroborates and accommodates every citizenry and vice-versa; but the power dynamics involved in generating and manufacturing the discourse of and around nation-state needs to be problematized.

The iconography of respective stalwarts of the liberal Centrist, Leftist, and the Rightist stream of thought were always prominent. But Bahujan iconography of Phule, Shahu, Savitribai, Periyar, Ambedkar has become a part and parcel of the vocabulary of youth (specifically in universities) around and after 1990. This is despite the fact that the presence of Bahujan, not only vis-à-vis population, but also with respect to creativity and expression has always existed. One can trace it back to Ravidas, Kabir, Dadu, Tukaram etc.

The role of Bahujan thus, in the phenomenon of building a nation-state, has to be gauged, established and owned. In the modern day struggle of narrative and perception, revival and mainstreamization of one's own perception and narrative is fundamental to its socio-political manifestation.

This seminar intends to foreground vision of anti-caste intellectuals, formulating anew their own utopia, representing Enlightenment in India, strengthening values of democracy, equality, rationality and progress.

The seminar proposes to bring together researchers interested and invested in the interface between anticaste discourse and the social vision of the anti-caste intellectuals towards not only a critical understanding of India, but also a utopic visualization of an Enlightened India - from the Bhakti radical to Ambedkar's casteless 'Prabudhdh Bharat'.

The seminar aims at moving across disciplines to facilitate discussions around the following themes:

- History of the anti-caste discourse in India
- Utopia of the anti-caste intellectuals
- Indian Knowledge Systems and the Outcastes
- Spaces and Non-Spaces of Contemporary
- Modern Liberal Universities and Caste Practices
- Caste in Cyberspace and the Future of India
- Caste and Media
- Interrogating caste-based identity politics
- Defining 'Ambedkarism', 'Periyarism' and 'Phuleism'
- Dalit aesthetics as anticasteism
- Dalit feminism as anticasteism
