5. Invited speakers, their affiliation and brief profile of each speaker:

Dr. Saurabh Ji is an *Assistant Professor* in the *Department of Sanskrit* at the Faculty of Arts, University of Delhi. He successfully completed his studies from the prestigious Kirorimal College of University of Delhi and also earned his Ph.D. from the University of Delhi.

His *research interests* span *Indian Epigraphy, Paleography, Chronology, Culture and Civilization*. He has supervised both Doctoral and M.Phil. thesis and has authored over 12 research papers in esteemed journals. He is actively engaged in the academic community, presenting papers at national and international seminars and participating as a resource person in various conferences and workshops. He has also coordinated and convened numerous faculty induction programs, organized seminars, conferences and refresher courses.

His contributions have been recognized with several awards, including the
'*Atmanirbhar Education Award 2024*' at the Atmanirbhar Digital Bharat Summit 2024 and the
'*Shiksha Bharti Samman, 2022*' from CED India Foundation registered under the Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises, Government of India, and NITI Ayog. He also received multiple
Samaradhak Shikshak Samman awards from the Delhi Sanskrit Academy for 2016-2017 and 2017-2018. He has been also a member in the expert panel in the
Indian Council of Social Science Research (ICSSR).

6. Brief summary of the event:

On October 25, 2024, the Indian Knowledge System Center at Ram Lal Anand College hosted an orientation program, where DU's Deputy Proctor, Dr. Saurabh was the guest. Under the guidance of Principal Prof. Rakesh Kumar Gupta, the event began with the Saraswati Vandana and the lighting of the lamp, performed by the students of the Gyan Dastoor Committee.

Prof. Archana Gaur, the center's advisor, honored the guest with a sapling, accompanied by nodal officer Dr. Kirti Punia and members Dr. Basant Mishra and Dr. Roshan Lal Meena.

Dr. Kirti Punia, the nodal officer, first expressed gratitude to the principal for his support. She explained that IKS (Indian Knowledge System) is an excellent initiative by the Government of India, AICTE, and UGC, aimed at promoting India's rich knowledge and heritage worldwide. She highlighted the importance of connecting ancient knowledge with today's modern world and encouraged students to get involved with the center. Dr Roshan Lal Meena stated that the center is open to students from all disciplines, with the main aim of providing full support for internships and research in the future. Dr. Basant then elaborated on the center's mission, explaining that its vision is to promote interdisciplinary research by expanding IKS for social applications. The goal is to raise awareness about ancestral knowledge across various fields through academic means. The center will actively engage in spreading the rich heritage and traditional knowledge of our country in areas such as arts and literature, agriculture, basic sciences, engineering and technology, architecture, management, economics, and more.

The entire program was hosted by students: Mahi Gautam (Department of English) and Aman Sharma (Political Science), while students from the BJMC Department covered the event. And all students coordinators helped to maintain the discipline and the decorum of the entire Orientation.
