

THEME ROLE OF G20 SUMMITS' IN ADDRESSING ENVIRONMENTAL ISSUES

ROUND 1

The very first round will be a Debate Competition. On the given topic, the participants have to deliver arguments whether in support of it or against the motion. Any one participant out of a team of two participants, will be given a time span of 5-7 minutes to speak about the topic. However, cross-questioning will be allowed in this round. The next and last round will be of Group Discussion. The qualifying teams will be only a part of this round.

This round will be an open argument round in which participants can discuss and cross-question other teams on the same theme. This round will be of 30 minutes.

Elimination Round:

After the Round 1, there will be an elimination round. Only the selected teams will be eligible to participate in the next round.

Elimination Round (Judging Criteria):

Way of speech delivery, Code of conduct, Knowledge about the topic and Originality of the content.

SETTING UP THE CONTEST

The entries will be recorded using google form as the main form of registration.

To allow for fair competition, students from other colleges will be allowed to roam and explore the college campus. Additionally, Vasudha volunteers can be assigned to each team to help them explore the campus in the prep-time.

WORKING OF EACH ROUND

Number of rounds would be 5 for 20 expected entries. However, if there is a situation of 20+ entries we will conduct an online quiz to reduce number of contestants.

However, if the contestant team breaks any rule the runner-up team will be considered the winner.


