Grapes and raisins are among the most popular natural snacks. Today there are more than 8000 varieties of grapes, grown specifically for wine, juice, jams and jellies. Grapes contain vitamin A, B and C and help to prevent several kinds of cancer and heart disease. Raisins, the dried form of grapes, are high in iron and carbohydrates.

When buying grapes look for plump fruit with good colour. Wrinkled and soft grapes mean that the fruit has lost its freshness, taste and value. Store grapes in the refrigerator, wrapped in plastic. Don't wash them until they are ready to be used.

Remember the commercially produced grapes are sprayed with pesticides. They should be washed thoroughly in cold, running water. Organically grown grapes should be washed to remove dirt. Grapes are best when served chilled.
