- 3. "Slight is the subject, but not so the praise." Discuss Pope's *The Rape of the Lock* in the light of the above statement.
- 4. The Duchess of Malfi reflects an anxiety about class and gender that marks Jacobean tragedy.
- 5. Subversion of authority is a significant aspect of the literature of the 17th and 18th Centuries. Discuss with reference to any of the texts in your course.
- 6. Discuss the construction of a hero in any two of the texts in your course.
