Speaker Session on the topic "Application of Statistics in Governance and Service Delivery" byMs. Soma Royburman

Ms. Soma Roy Burman is a distinguished figure in the fields of finance and government administration, bringing with her a wealth of experience spanning over 35 years. Her academic achievements include earning an M.Sc and M. Phil degree in Mathematical Statistics with distinction from the University of Delhi. Throughout her career, she held pivotal roles within the Indian government, including Director/Joint Secretary on Central/other Deputations. Notably, Ms.Burman served as the Controller General of Accounts from December 2019 until her retirement in July 2021, where she played a pivotal role in shaping accounting principles for the Government of India and overseeing the finalization of Union Government Accounts.

The presentation presented by her was informative, engaging and thought provoking with charts and diagrams for better understanding. She briefly covered topics like economic Indicators and analysis using statistics, Budgeting and Fiscal Policy, Public Policy Evaluation, Financial Markets and Investments, Monetary Policy and Central Banking, Risk Management and Insurance, Government Surveys and Census Data, Regulatory Compliance and Compliance Monitoring, Forecasting and Trend Analysis, Public Finance Management, Stress Testing and Scenario Analysis, Data Privacy and Security. She made the session highly engaging by actively involving both faculty members and students. She encouraged students to share their doubts, and they took the opportunity to ask a range of questions. The insights and perspective she shared were truly valuable and the audience was extremely engaged. Overall, the webinar was extremely knowledgeable.
