## AMBEDKAR NATIONAL MEMORIAL TRIP

## **REPORT**

On the 6<sup>th</sup> April of 2022, Department of Political Science students went to Ambedkar national memorial with the support of Nidhi ma'am and Sunil Sir. All the students present on that day gained an impressive experience in learning about Ambedkar's life (14 April 1891-06 Dec. 1956), his educational qualification, his struggle in bringing socio-political-economical equality to all the sections of society and many more.

With the help of teachers and tourist guide present there, students explore many things that how the constitution-making process take place by different political leaders under the chairmanship of Ambedkar. The presence of the Ambedkar statue gives a real view of his speech about the French Revolution. The monument is designed in a book-shaped which refers to the book of Constitution of India. Students learnt that being born in lower caste(mahar), he was the most educated person in his caste as well as in other caste also.

As explained by the tourist guide and teachers he got the title of 'baba' after his wife death when he dressed like a monk and started to live in that way for few years. Students learned that for the upliftment of lower caste he founded many organisations like Bahishkrit Hitakarni Sabha(1924), Independent Labour Party(1936), weekly paper 'Mooknayak' (leader of the dumb) and published many books also.

After successfully visiting Ambedkar memorial trip ended with a good and hygienic food provided by department and with the photo session combing all the students present there.
