This year Department touched great heights with grant Financial support and Star status underDBT "**Star College Scheme**", Ministry of Science and Technology under Coordinator Dr Prerna Diwan.Dr. Prerna Diwan and Dr Rakesh Kumar Guptahave been awarded two extramural research grants from ICSSRand ICMR.Department faculty and students also have been selected for 5 inhouse college research grants.

**Orientation** for new students was held on Monday 22<sup>nd</sup>July 2019. Several national, international eventsand outreach programswere organized in the department throughout the year.

Aman Singh was elected as President, Pragya Kumar as Vice-President, Anurag Singh as Secretary and Yugansh Gupta as Treasurer of the societyMikrobiologika. AnEducational visit to the exhibition "Superbugs: The End of Antibiotics?" by National Council of Science Museums (NCSM) in collaboration with Science Museum Group, London (UK) at National Science Centre for students was organized on 01-10-2019

Three alumni interaction sessions were held this year.
