# Information for the 98<sup>th</sup> ANNUAL REPORT (2020-21) University of Delhi

#### 1. Name of The College: Ram Lal Anand College

#### 2. Major Activities and Achievements:

The Academic session 2020-21 remained productive despite the lockdown due to ongoing pandemic. While uncertainties still persist, we remained focused on our ambitions and dedicated towards creating a culture of academic excellence keeping a regular dialogue with different stakeholders. The faculty smoothly made a transition to online mode of teaching. The College enhanced its IT support and infrastructure. The students and faculty were provided with G-Suite account facility with Institutional email IDs for online classes and to have Google classroom access. A **FDP on ICT Tools and LMS** was conducted for all faculty members before the start of academic session 2020-21 to facilitate online teaching covering all platforms including Google Meet, Google Classroom, Canvas, JioMeet, Zoom, Photo and Video Editing tools.

The pass percentage of outgoing batch 2017-20 was 93.1%. In 2020-21, a total of 871 admissions were done against 886 sanctioned seats in various programmes. An online Orientation Program for new students enrolled in 2020-21 was held on 20<sup>th</sup> November 2020 using the Zoom platform that was attended by more than 600 students and parents. For Open Book Examinations of final year students, all necessary information and advisories were regularly shared with students through a dedicated tab on the website, email and class Whatsapp groups. Students have been given remote access to Library Resources via NList membership so that they can have reading material access at home. For Visually Challenged students, the prescribed books were shared after being converted to VH readable E-Texts.

For curriculum enrichment, **the college offered 21 skill development certificate courses** for students (without any additional fees) in online mode so as to utilize the lockdown Period constructively. Also, there were a total of 749 certificate course

completions including 13 specialised courses by students and faculty on Coursera platform.

For physical and mental fitness of students and staff, a course on **Yoga and meditation** has been running since 1st June 2020 in online mode. The **Human values, Ethics and Life Skills** course was also offered in online mode to all semester I students. Three new short term courses for preparation of Entrance examinations (CAT, PO, SSC, Civil services etc) were conducted by CCPC. Among other new initiatives, a **Book bank Facility with** a provision of complete set of course books for needy students of all programmes has been financially approved by Governing Body. A **Gender Sensitization Committee** has been constituted under the staff council. Two new journals "Asmi" and "Journal of Human Values, Ethics and Life Skills" (multi-disciplinary) have been approved.

The college has also started an **Endowment Fund** under which donations of INR **8 lacs has been received** from the college this year from stakeholders and public. The funds received will be utilized for the purpose of scholarships or awards for the meritorious students.

Long pending process of **Promotions of 36 faculty members** from Stage 1 to Associate Professor levels have been completed. No backlogs of promotion cases is pending. **3 members of Non-teaching staff** were granted financial upgradation under MACP, **4 Non- teaching staff have been promoted.** 

During this academic session, one International Conference, 3 National Conferences, 8 International Seminars, 4 National Seminars, 7 Alumni lectures, 5 faculty/professional Development Programs and 11 workshops have been conducted.

An amount of **INR 24.54 lacs have been sanctioned to make the campus barrierfree** for students with disability. Installation of a 100KW Solar Plant on college roof top has been approved. A grant of **INR 50 lacs has been approved for development of Studio Theatre from Ministry of Culture**, Government of India.
