## ISS SPECIAL CAMP











THE NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME UNIT OF RAM LAL ANAND COLLEGE, UNIVERSITY OF DELHI WAS ON ITS SPECIAL CAMP FROM FEBRUARY 2ND TO 9TH .FOR THE SAME THE CULTURALLY AND HISTORICALLY RICH CITY OF JAISALMER WAS CHOSEN. A TOTAL OF 40 VOLUNTEERS ALONG WITH 4 FACULTY MEMBERS INCLUDING THE PROGRAMME OFFICER DR ANURAG SHARMA TRAVELLED FROM DELHI TO JAISALMER . THE ACTIVITIES OF THE CAMP WERE DESIGNED ACCORDING TO THE NEEDS AND PROBLEMS OF THE LOCAL COMMUNITY. THE CAMP COMMENCED WITH THE UNIT'S VISIT TO GOVERNMENT SCHOOLS IN VILLAGE SONU AND RANAO AND LATER TO TANOT WHERE THE ASSIGNED GROUPS INTERACTED WITH STUDENTS OF VARYING STREAMS, IDENTIFIED THE ISSUES OF WOMEN AND GUIDED THEM IN FUTURE EDUCATIONAL OPPORTUNITIES.













THE NEXT DAY VOLUNTEERS VISITED THE ZERO LINE BORDER AND INTERACTED WITH BSF PERSONNEL. THE UNIT ALSO PAID VISIT TO LONGEWALA WAR MEMORIAL. A CLEANLINESS DRIVE WAS CONDUCTED IN THE SAND DUNES AT SAM.

FOR THE NEXT THREE DAYS OF THE CAMP VOLUNTEERS VISITED VILLAGES AND REFUGEE COLONIES AND CONDUCTED A NUMBER OF SOCIO-ECONOMIC SURVEYS IN ORDER TO IDENTIFY THE PROBLEMS AND POTENTIAL OF THE PLACES AND PEOPLE WHICH HAVE BEEN UNNOTICED. THE SURVEYED VILLAGES INCLUDE GAMNEWALA, DAMODARA AND AMARSAGAR ALONG WITH REFUGEE COLONIES .THE SURVEY WAS FOLLOWED BY ANOTHER CLEANLINESS DRIVE THAT WAS CONDUCTED AT VILLAGE DAMODARA NEAR THE LAKE.









VOLUNTEERS MET THE SPECIALLY ABLED CHILDREN AT JAISALMER VISHESH VIDYALAYA HOUSING BOARD AND ENGAGED WITH THEM IN VARIOUS LEARNING ACTIVITIES LIKE SIGN LANGUAGE, READING, WRITING. ETC.THE CAMP ACTIVITIES CONCLUDED WITH A CLEANLINESS DRIVE NEAR MAHESHWARI SEVA SADAN, THE STAY OF THE UNIT FOR 5 DAYS, AND LATER IN THE EVENING AT THE GADISAR LAKE. VOLUNTEERS VISITED THE JAISALMER FORT AND WITNESSED THE RICH CULTURE AND HERITAGE OF RAJASTHAN.

THE CAMP ENSURED THE DEVELOPMENT OF PERSONALITY AND CHARACTER OF STUDENT YOUTH AND A SENSE OF SOCIAL AND CIVIC RESPONSIBILITY AMONG THEMSELVES.
















## BIART PORTAL REGISTRATION









IN RESPONSE TO THE NATIONWIDE INITIATIVE TO STREAMLINE DIGITAL SERVICES AND ENSURE EFFICIENT GOVERNANCE. THE NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME AT OUR COLLEGE ORGANISED A DESK DRIVE TO FACILITATE STUDENT REGISTRATIONS ON THE BHARAT PORTAL. THE PRIMARY OBJECTIVE WAS TO ENCOURAGE STUDENT ENGAGEMENT WITH THE DIGITAL PLATFORM AND ENHANCE THEIR ACCESS TO GOVERNMENT SERVICES. DURING THE DRIVE, **VOLUNTEERS GUIDED STUDENTS THROUGH THE REGISTRATION** PROCESS ENSURING THAT ALL REQUIRED INFORMATION WAS ACCURATELY PROVIDED. SPECIAL ATTENTION WAS GIVEN TO STUDENTS WITHOUT A VOTER ID CARD, WHO WERE ASSISTED IN COMPLETING THE NECESSARY STEPS TO REGISTER ON THE BHARAT PORTAL. THE DRIVE SUCCESSFULLY FACILITATED MORE THAN 124 STUDENT REGISTRATIONS ON THE BHARAT PORTAL, SIGNIFICANTLY EXPANDING THE DIGITAL FOOTPRINT OF OUR COLLEGE COMMUNITY. THE NSS DESK DRIVE FOR BHARAT PORTAL REGISTRATIONS HAD A POSITIVE IMPACT ON STUDENT ENGAGEMENT WITH DIGITAL **GOVERNANCE INITIATIVES.** 










