We are introducing an Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP) system to streamline the management of various aspects, including Attendance, Timetable, Optional paper selection, Internal Assessment, and Society events.

You can also log in to the ERP portal through the Student Login link on the college website with your college email ID as username and password, which has been shared on your college email ID. After login, you are all required to choose optional papers as per the CBCS-LOCF curriculum in the following categories: Generic Elective (GE), Skill Enhancement Course (SEC), and Discipline Elective Courses (DSE). **You can see these papers inside the Optional Paper Selection module using a web browser login only**. The option to submit the choices for these papers will activate on <u>18 January 2024</u>. Meanwhile, you can check the list of papers offered and their syllabus and decide which paper to opt for. **The last date to fill out your options is 20 January 2024**.

### **For Honours Courses Students:**

- Every student of B.A.(H)/ B.Sc.(H)/B.Com.(H)/BMS need to study two Core papers and two Discipline Specific Elective (DSE) papers.
- In the departments where more than 2 DSE are offered, students need to pick two DSE.

# For B.A.(PROG) Courses Students:

- Students of B.A.(PROG) will study 2 Discipline Specific Core (DSC) papers of their respective combinations, one GE and one SEC.
- Students need to choose one from the list of GEs. Students cannot choose the GE paper offered by their respective departments offering the DSC papers. For example, students of the B.A.(P) History+Political Science combination cannot study GE offered by History and Political Science.
   GE1: Multimedia and Web Design (Computer Science)
   GE2: Investigating Inequalities (History)
   GE3: Human Rights, Gender and Environment (Political Science)
- Students can choose one of the following SECs irrespective of the department offering that paper:

**SEC1:** Data Visualization using R (Computer Science) **SEC2:** Radio Cinema in India : A Social History (History) **SEC3:** Conflict and Peace Building (Political Science)

Students who have not studied Hindi till class 8<sup>th</sup> need to appear for the paper **Compulsory Test in Hindi (CTH)** in two semesters. <u>*This paper is compulsory for receiving the degree.*</u> All these students should email <u>archanagaur.hin@rla.du.ac.in</u> regarding this paper.

The last date to submit options online through the Student Login in College Website/ App (SmartProf RLAC) is 20 January 2024, failing which the student(s) will not be able to exercise her choice and shall be allotted paper(s) by the college. Please note that no choice will be entertained in any other form. The choice of subject has to be submitted only through this portal.
